

TARGET DURATION ACROSS THE YIELD CURVE WITH BONDBLOXX U.S. TREASURY ETFS





WHY PRECISE DURATION MATTERS IN U.S. TREASURY INVESTING

U.S. Treasury ETFs can offer a simple way to access government bonds and generate income, but most aim to provide broad maturity exposure that can make it difficult to maintain a target duration. Duration measures a bond's sensitivity to changes in interest rates. As rates change, the duration of these ETFs can drift meaningfully over time, increasing interest-rate sensitivity and forcing investors to actively monitor and rebalance portfolios to stay aligned with their risk and return objectives. The chart below illustrates drift that may be experienced by investors in U.S. Treasury ETFs tracking single on-the-run maturity or maturity-range indices compared to a target duration index in the intermediate segment of the yield curve.
